



Uncommon Sized Drum Bungs - How to Measure & Identify

In NZ we have a lot of recycled drums and that is why there are lots of uncommon sized bungs around. Drum manufacturers have copied the standard threads but made them different sizes. These are mostly coming from China, Korea and India.

To help identify which bungs you need firstly check if they are **fine** or **coarse** thread. Next measure across the thread at the widest part. What does the top look like? It is also helpful to check the bung or drum for the country of origin and a manufacturer. It is most helpful to send us a photo with measurements.

The common sizes are 2" BSP (57mm), 2" Buttruss (56mm or 64mm) and (Mauser 70mm). If your bung is none of these sizes we may not be able to supply replacements for you. Unfortunately, the only one we can still access is 800635, below.
